What makes QUALITY Data?

Complete:

 Facility data has been submitted for each month (or for each quarter in the case of TB data)

Consistent:

Similar to the value for other months

Correct:

 Value for one data element is similar to the value for a related data element (e.g. DPT 3 is about equal to Polio 3)

• Current (Timeliness):

Data submitted before the deadlines
